

How to grade a discussion topic with a rubric

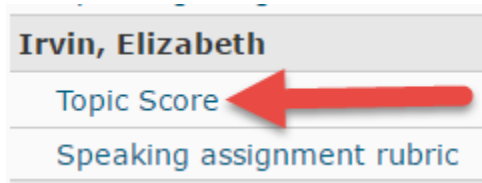

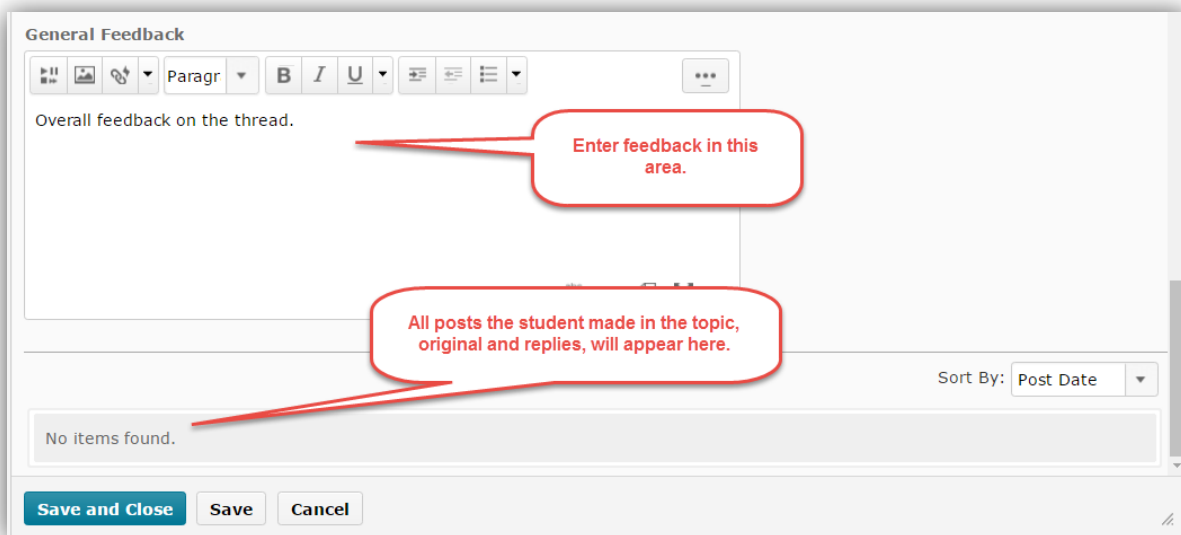
